"Known all men by these Present that we Samuel Lilley of Stafford in the County of Hartford in Connecticut Colony and John Lilley of Dudley in the County of Worcester and Province of the Massachusetts Bay in new England and Jonathan and David Lillie both of Sutton in the County of Worcester and Province of the Massachusetts Bay in new England and Ebenezer Dagget and Hannah Dagget and Timothy Carter and Elizabeth Carter his wife all of Sutton in the County of Worcester and Province of the Massachusetts Bay in new England and John Parker and Sarah Parker his wife and Jacob Gibbs of Hopkington and Mary his wife in the County of Middlesex and Province of the Massachusetts Bay in new England being Heir to the personal Estate of our honoured Father Samuel Lilley of Sutton in the County of Worcester in the Province of Massachusetts Bay in new England Do have agreed and divided said Estate to Each of our Satisfaction and do by these oblige and bind ourselves and our Heirs to abide by this agreement forever as Witness our Hand this 24th. Day of January - 1753 - Samuel Lillie John Lillie Jonathan Lillie David Lillie, Ebenezer Dagget, Hannah her + mark Dagget, Timothy Carter, Elizabeth her + mark Carter, John Parker, Sarah her + mark Parker, Jacob Gibbs, Mary her + mark Gibbs -

Witnesses March 13th. 1753 Personally appeared Benjn. Morris and made oath that he saw Samuel Lillie and others who signed at the same Time who were Heirs to the Estate of Samuel Lillie Late of Sutton Decd. Sign the above agreement and at the same Time he saw Benjamin Dennis and John Parker Junr. Signe as Evidences together with himself to said agreement. Sworne Before Robert Goddard Justice of Peace"
